### **ALL SOULS DAY-NOVEMBER 2<sup>ND</sup>**

**Monday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>** is the day that we remember and pray for all the Holy Souls in Purgatory and we especially remember all those who died this past year. The faithful departed cannot pray for themselves and are dependant upon our prayers for them. Mass will be celebrated at 7 o’clock on Monday morning and at 7:00 p.m. we will pray Evening Prayer with benediction in the chapel for their repose,.
