EXPOSITION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT



The first Friday Eucharist Adoration devotion will take place on November 2nd in the Chapel between 7:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. The devotion begins immediately after the 7:00 a.m. Mass with the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament.

The purpose of adoration is to highlight the presence of Our Lord in the Eucharist. When a consecrated host is placed in the Monstrance, it is said to be a solemn exposition. We invite our parishioners as well as those from our cluster parishes to come and make a “visit” to the Lord present in the Blessed Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. Spend some time in His presence and experience the peace and blessings of prayer before the Lord. In the evening from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. the Holy Hour will take place in the Chapel followed by Benediction and will be conducted by Deacon Pat Mussulli. We encourage parishioners to attend this devotion.
