The 2008 mass book is now available. Intentions may be scheduled at the rectory during regular office hours. We would appreciate payment of the Mass offering at the time of reservation because many Mass offerings this year have not been paid and, unfortunately, are uncollectible.

As a reminder – Masses are not carried over from one year to another. Only **TWO WEEKEND OR HOLY DAY MASSES PER DECEASED** are allowed for the entire year. There is no limit to the number of weekday Masses (including Saturday morning) for anyone but no more than **ONE PER DECEASED** per week.

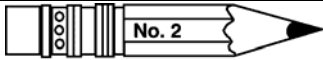
