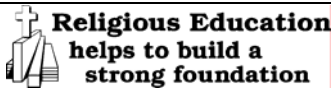
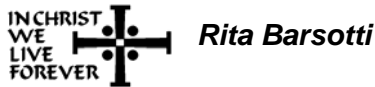

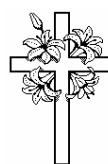

The **Children’s Choir** will be joining the **Adult Choir** at the 10:30 a.m. Mass on Palm Sunday, March 16th.

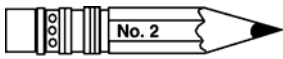
