MASS SCHEDULE BOOK FOR 2009

The scheduling of Mass intentions for 2009 will begin on Wednesday, June 25th in the Chapel Room of the lower church from 8:15 a.m. until noon. After noon, the Mass book will be available in the rectory. We would appreciate payment of the Mass offering at the time of reservation.

As a reminder – Masses are not carried over from one year to another. Only TWO WEEKEND OR HOLY DAY MASSES PER DECEASED are allowed for the entire year. There is no limit to the number of weekday Masses but no more than ONE PER DECEASED per week.

There will no longer be an 8:00 a.m Mass on Saturdays beginning in 2009.
