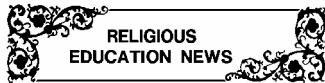
ROSE FOR LIFE DRIVE

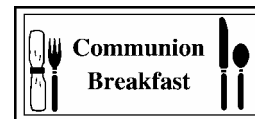


PRO-LIFE: Films with pro-life themes are shown each Wednesday 7:30 p.m. on Cable Channel 8.
