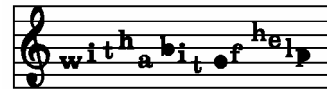

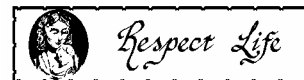
Next weekend our Parish will join Catholics across the country in a post-card signing campaign sending a message to the U.S. Senators urging them to oppose the passage of the **'FREEDOM OF CHOICE ACT' (FOCA)** expected to come before the Congress soon after the January inauguration...This bill poses a most serious threat to pro-life policies ever faced as it will; 1) force taxpayer funded abortions; 2) overturn the ban on 'partial-birth' abortions; 3) violate the conscience rights of doctors, nurses and hospitals, overturn informed consent laws and strip parents of their rights to be involved in their minor daughters' abortion decision. This campaign has been authorized by the U.S. Bishops in dioceses nationwide. We at Sacred Heart will be conducting the post-card campaign downstairs in the Chapel Room after all Masses on January 24-25.
