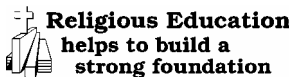

First Friday Devotions

As the days of Lent are quickly leading us to the most holy time of the Liturgical Year (Holy Week), we hear Jesus speak to us about the final prediction of His crucifixion and death on the Cross. Jesus, out of love for us and obedient to His Father, becomes the perfect sacrifice of reparation for our sins. *"And when I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw everyone to myself."* Don't pass up this opportunity to spend some time alone in prayer and adoration before the Real presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, this Friday, April 3rd from 7 and 11 a.m. in the lower Chapel. Place all your burdens before Him, pray for His guidance and strength for yourselves and your families, spend this time to prepare yourself to make a good confession before Easter. The Rosary will be prayed each hour on the half hour from 7:30 to 10:30 a.m. Come spend this time in quiet prayer for yourself, your family and for your country. If work commitments do not allow you to attend adoration during the day then join us for the Stations of the Cross that will be held on Friday night at 7:00 p.m. on April 3rd in the lower Chapel.



On April 11th at our Easter Vigil Dennis Swanson will be received into the Catholic Church and Erica Vercruysse will complete the sacraments of initiation. The RCIA Team invites you to pray for them and asks that you welcome them into the parish by sending them a note or a card.
