LENTEN REGULATIONS

ABSTINENCE from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and on all Fridays of Lent.

FASTING is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

Catholics should not excuse themselves lightly from these prescribed Lenten penitential practices.

Masses will be at 7:00 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. in the upper church. There will be a Scripture Service at 3:00 p.m. in the upper church.

The imposition of ashes will take place at both Masses and at the Scripture Service.

COLLECTION FOR CHURCH IN LATIN AMERICA

A collection for the church in Latin America will be taken up the weekend of February 20 and 21..The proceeds to this collection are distributed to dioceses, parishes, religious congregations, seminaries, and other Catholic institutions throughout Latin America and the Caribbean to assist in the formation of priests, religious, lay ministers, missionaries, pastoral workers, catechists, and youth ministers. A significant portion of the collection remains locally and assists those who are served by the Diocesan Hispanic Ministry.
