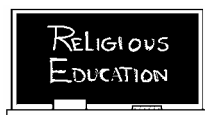

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS

On **Tuesday, July 20th**, a presentation on the **Holy Shroud of Turin** is coming to our parish. Deacon Roderick Cashes, from St. Edmonds Parish in Westminster will be the featured guest Speaker at the **Knights of Columbus Evening Social** to be held in the **Chapel Room at 7:00 p.m.** The Holy Shroud is kept at the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist in the city of Turin, Italy and has been traditionally thought to be the burial cloth of Jesus. This linen cloth contains a 'negative-print' image of a man's body that has undergone a severe beating and crucifixion. Deacon Rod has developed a presentation complete with actual photos displayed on a power-point program which he will share with us on this evening. We extend an invitation to all our parishioners to come and join us in listening to this powerful presentation. This is a great opportunity to learn more about history's most contested religious relic. The presentation is approximately 45 minutes long and will be followed by discussion and light refreshments.
